

POLICY FOR FLORISTS AT ST. MATTHEW CHURCH

The following directives must be observed:

1. Floral arrangements in the sanctuary must consist of natural flowers and materials. Normally, 2 floral arrangements for in front of the altar are sufficient. These arrangements are to be left as a gift to the church. The parish has 2 brass vases and 2 brass elevated vases available for use.
2. Florists will not move the altar furnishings or existing sanctuary arrangements to accommodate floral arrangements nor place anything on the Altar of Sacrifice.
3. A rose or other floral arrangement is permitted for the presentation to Our Lady.
4. The flower girl or any other bridal attendant is not permitted to drop flowers or flower petals in the main aisle during the processional.
5. Throwing rice, birdseed or any other objects is prohibited inside or outside of the church.
6. Pew markers/decorations may not be attached with tape because it damages the wood finish. Rubber bands are recommended.
7. No additional candelabras, lamps, or candle arrangements from the florist are permitted.
8. No floral arches are permitted.
9. No aisle runners are permitted.
10. Decorating may begin at 12:30 p.m. on the day of the wedding for the 2:00 Wedding. For the 11:00a. m. Wedding, decorating may begin at 9:30a.m.
